In the “**March into Reading challenge**”, A “Book in a Red Village Bag” is sent home. An adult reads the book with the student or the student reads to someone, that evening. The adult posts a picture of your child reading, being read to or posing with the “Book and the Red Village Bag” to our Facebook page, using **@ittakesavillagepreschool** and using the hashtag **#MarchIntoReading**. Finally, the student returns the “Book and the Red Village Bag” to the classroom teachers the next morning so it can go home with another classmate.
